### **DRAFT MINUTES BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION August 5, 2020**

6 The Town of Bow Business Development Commission held a scheduled regular meeting on Wednesday, August  
7 5, 2020 at 7:30 AM via Zoom.

9 Chair Bill Hickey was not present and Larry Haynes was the chairing the meeting. Mr. Haynes called the meeting  
10 to order at 7:31 AM with a roll call attendance. Other BDC Members participating were: Cody Herrick, Chris  
11 Johnson, Mike Percy, John Meissner, Don Berube, Jr., and Selectmen Matt Poulin. Also participating were: Dave  
12 Stack, Town Manager, Bow Police Chief Margaret Lougee, Director of Community Development Matt Taylor,  
13 Assistant Planner Bryan Westover, and recording secretary Alvina Snegach. Colleen Hunter, June Branscom, and  
14 Wendy Gazaway were excused. Stan Emanuel was in the audience as a member of the public.

16 **Approval of minutes - 06/03/2020**

17 06/03/2020 minutes were reviewed. *Mr. Poulin made a motion to approve the minutes as presented, which was*  
18 *duly seconded by Mr. Herrick and passed by a unanimous vote in favor.*

20 **Review project/task list and reports from boards and committees.**

21 Mr. Taylor and Mr. Stack provided brief updates on the following:

- 22 - Proposed commercial developments on Thibeault Drive and Tallwood Drive;
- 23 - Dunklee Road Intersection and Bridge repair progress;
- 24 - July water sales from the municipal public water system to the water haulers;
- 25 - Water line extension to Bow Junction project status;
- 26 - Recent Planning and Zoning Board approvals and upcoming applications.

27 **Other Business**

28 Members briefly discussed the prospects of conducting the Business to Business event and what would virtual  
29 options be.

30 Mr. Poulin provided a brief update on the Board of Selectmen communications with the City of Concord  
31 regarding water interconnection.

32 Mr. Taylor answered some questions about the progress of the Bow-Concord 1-89/-193 Project and said that he  
33 will send the preferred alternative plan to the members and Mr. Poulin will bring the issue up at the next BOS  
34 meeting.

35 Mr. Haynes said that a Town Official Referral Form has been received for a Planning Board application on Ryan  
36 Road for an addition to the site plan with the cold storage building. General consensus was that there are no  
37 concerns.

38 Mr. Haynes said that he was very sad to learn that Mr. Hickey's mother had passed recently and expressed  
39 deepest sympathies on behalf of all the members. He asked everyone to keep Mr. Hickey in their thoughts.

40 Motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Poulin, duly seconded by Mr. Percy and approved by a unanimous vote in  
41 favor.
