III. PUBLIC HEARING

1. Pushee/Chadwick Land Donation

Chairman Nicolopoulos opened the Public Hearing at 6:00 p.m. on the Pushee/Chadwick Land Donation, and gave a brief overview of the Pushee/Chadwick land donation.

Conservation Commission Chair Sandy Crystall confirmed the Commission's support of the Town's acceptance of land donated by the Pushee/Chadwick family. Chair Crystall went on to say the commission is supportive of a Conservation Easement with Bow Open Spaces, who is also in support of this action.

Chairman Nicolopoulos inquired whether the conservation easement was a condition as part of the donation. Chair Crystall stated it was not a condition, as part of the donation.

With there being no public comments, Chairman Nicolopoulos closed the public hearing at 6:10 p.m.

A MOTION was made by Selectman Poulin and duly seconded by Selectman Marshall to graciously accept the land donated by the Pushee/Chadwick Family, contingent upon the conservation easement with Bow Open Spaces. MOTION PASSED 5-0.
