

Summary

Turee Pond Fish Survey – 8/15/2017

All Data Provided by Matt Carpenter, NH F&G

- 6 Species Identified – Largemouth Bass, Blue Gill, Eastern Chain Pickeral, Yellow Perch, Pumpkinseed, & Black Crappie
- Results
 - Biologists shocked for a total of 2000 seconds and counted 61 Fish
 - Biologists commented “Expected to see more fish given the type of habitat”
- Comparisons with Previous Surveys
 - Last Surveyed August 9, 2000
 - Different Protocol Used but overall catch rate per second was similar
 - Notable Differences
 - Huge Decrease in Weight of Largemouth Bass. Average weight dropped by 50%. Weight loss was a larger percentage in longer fish
 - Black Crappie has somehow been introduced into the pond.
 - Pumpkinseed Population in 2000 has been replaced by Blue Gill. Blue Gill can withstand warmer water than Pumpkinseed.
 - Not enough Eastern Chain Pickeral were caught to make a good 2017/2000 comparison.
 - Increased TP level and reduced water clarity may contribute to changes.
