Chapter 85

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Article I
Acquisition or Sale of Property

[HISTORY. Adopted 3-9-2005 Town Meeting as Art. 37.]

§ 85-1. Authorization.

- A. The Board of Selectmen, per the provisions of RSA 41:14-a, is authorized to acquire or sell land, buildings, or both provided that they submit any such acquisitions or sales to the planning board, the Heritage Commission or Historical Commission, and the Conservation Commission for their review and recommendation in accordance with the provisions of the statute.
- B. This authorization does not apply to Town owned conservation land, any part of a town forest, or real estate given, devised, or bequeathed to the Town for charitable or community purposes.

Article II
Sale of Tax Deeded Property

[HISTORY. Adopted 3-9-1994 Town Meeting Article No. 25.]

§ 85-2. Adoption of statutory authorization.

The Town voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen to dispose of tax deeded property in accordance with the provisions of RSA 80:80. This authorization shall remain in effect until rescinded by a vote of the Town Meeting.

Article III
Leasing of Land for Communications Towers

[HISTORY. Adopted 3-9-2005 Town Meeting Article No. 38.]

§ 85-3. Authorization.

- A. The Board of Selectmen is authorized to lease Town owned land to be used for the construction and installation of communication towers.
- B. This authorization does not extend to conservation land established under RSA 36-A or land given devised, or bequeathed to the town for charitable purposes under RSA 36-A or land give, devised, or bequeathed to the town for charitable purposes.
