§ 105-1. Purpose.

The purposes of the Building and Facilities Advisory Committee are as follows:

- A. Assess and analyze municipally owned buildings and facilities in order to prioritize physical plant needs and budgets.
- B. Develop a facilities assessment and analysis methodology and process that informs decision makers and enables priority-setting among Capital Improvement Program (CIP), replacement, renovation, and maintenance projects.
- C. Advise the Board of Selectmen, Town Manager and Building and Facilities Manager, on building and facilities priorities, including construction, replacement, renovation, and maintenance, and the development of an overall facilities strategy.

§ 105-2. Membership. [Amended 5-14-24 by Board of Selectmen, Ord. No. 24-02]

- A. Membership will include five members from the general public appointed by the Board of Selectmen, one member from the Board of Selectmen, one member from the School Board, and the Town Facilities Manager (non-voting).
- B. Members should have demonstrated experience in facilities planning, architecture, construction management, or some combination thereof. While these qualifications are desired, they are not absolute and appointments may be made for members without having the aforementioned qualifications,
- C. Terms of membership shall be 3 years. Initial terms shall be set for 1, 2, and 3 years, and thereafter be set at 3 years. Members may be re-appointed for subsequent terms.
